# Fall Semester Courses Begin August 27 Suitable for High School Students

Depending on availability, high school students can take college courses online or at Helena College, offered at times convenient for juniors and seniors. These courses are required in several Career Pathways and are scheduled August 27 through December 14. **High school students pay half tuition for** *College Credit Only or Dual Credit*.

### **General Education Courses**

- These courses fulfill requirements in several college programs, such as Associates of Arts or Sciences, which can be transferred as a block to the four-year programs of the Montana University System.
- The General Education Core Curriculum includes 6 credits in Natural Sciences, 3 credits in Mathematics, 3 credits in Written Communications, 3 credits in Oral Communications, 6 credits in Social & Psychological Sciences/History, 6 credits in Humanities/Fine Arts, and 3 credits in Cultural Diversity.
- Several College Writing, Literature and Mathematics courses are also offered as dual enrollment at high schools.

**General Education Courses** generally transfer to other Montana colleges.
