With the new 1-2-Free Program, taking college courses online or at Helena College is a smart choice. The courses listed here are offered at times convenient for juniors and seniors and scheduled January 14 through May 8. Students should apply as soon as possible (if they have never taken a Dual Enrollment course) and can begin registering December 3, 2018. After the first six college credits, high school students pay half tuition for Dual Enrollment Courses or nothing if eligible for DE Scholarships. (See counselors to apply.)
