

Windows VPN Install Instructions:


First go to <https://evpn2.umt.edu> in a web browser –




User your Missoula NetID like the example below and password. Same one that you use for Cyberbear.




Then select continue.




A web page will open up to download the installer for Windows Computer Software.




Click on the "Download for Windows" and Select "Next" on the next screen.






Read and Accept the terms and License Agreement and select "Next".




Go ahead and click "Install" on this next screen.

Wait for the install wizard to install the client.




Go ahead at this next screen and select "Finish" to complete the install.

There is also another set of instructions here, if needed.




When it is finished installing, sometimes nothing notifies you that it is installed, and the first time you must find it in your recently added apps, or you can search for Cisco AnyConnect and you will see it as an option to open the app.


Go ahead and open it.




When it opens it should have evpn2.umt.edu in the VPN box, if not type it in and select "Connect".




It should look like this.




Then another box opens up and that is where you use your Missoula NetID again, the same one you use for Cyberbear to login to the VPN software.




You will get a pop up that looks like this, go ahead and select "Accept" and you will be connected.



The next time you go to get into the VPN, all you have to do is go to the hidden icons under the up arrow in the clock area of the lower task bar. If you click it, you will see Icons such as these and you are looking for the small grey globe with green and blue lines and a lock in front of it. You can click this to connect, see your status anytime and also to disconnect. See below.



Note that there is a time limit that you can be connected and also appears to be a 2 connection limit at one time, for 2 devices simultaneously.



Your drives will say disconnected with a red X on them. Click on them one time, once the VPN is connected and the red X will go away and you should be able to use shortcuts to the drive you have opened, until the next time you login to VPN again, you will have to open the drive one time when you first login.
