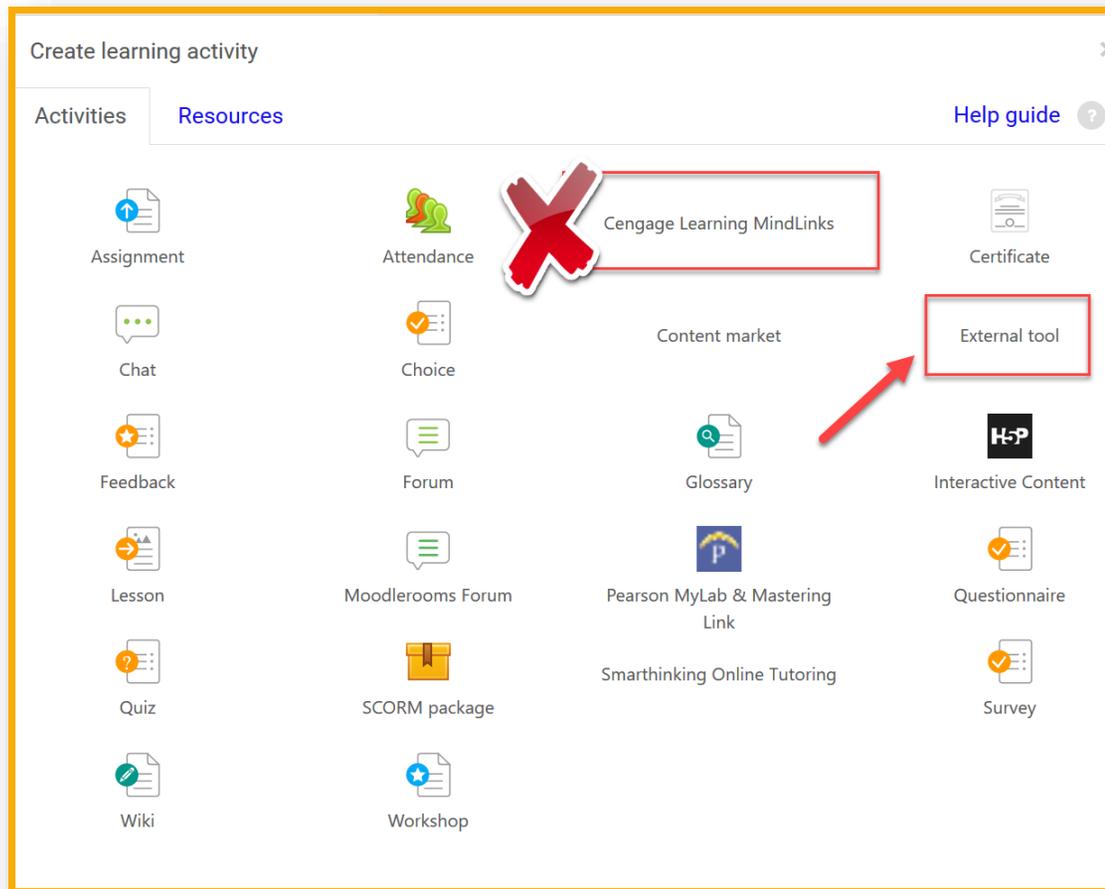


## Using Cengage Learning MindLinks in Moodle

(1) Go to your Moodle course and add “**External tool**” from the Activity Chooser, **do NOT** choose “**Cengage Learning MindLinks**”.



(2) Refer to the email that you got from Cengage, copy the given Course URL into the “Tool URL” in Moodle.

**1. Copy Cengage Course URL**  
Copy the following URL and follow Quick Start Guide instructions to add the link within your LMS course.

**2. Add the Cengage Course URL**

**3. Copy Cengage Content Selector URL**  
Add the following optional Cengage Content Selector URL to your course to allow you to easily browse a list of all available resource links and add them to your LMS course. Only instructors can access this link. Therefore, it should not be made available to students in your course.

(3) You should also have received a **Quick Start Guide** from Cengage – Fill in the required fields in Moodle using the information given in the **Quick Start Guide**.

### An example

This shows how students can get connected with Cengage resources if instructors add the Cengage Learning MindLinks in their Moodle course.

- Students can log directly into **Cengage Learning MindLinks** resources if instructors added the “**Cengage Learning MindLinks**” into their course in Moodle.
- Linking to **Cengage Learning MindLinks** with the Moodle course allows instructors to save time generating their own teaching materials while benefitting from resources available elsewhere.
- When students click the “**Cengage Learning MindLinks**” added by their instructor in Moodle, they are automatically signed into the **Cengage Learning MindLinks** and can use the resources (for example, take a quiz, enter an eBook, read learning notes, etc) immediately.
- When the student has completed the assessment, **Cengage Learning MindLinks** displays their grade (screenshot 2 below) and when the student logs out of **Cengage Learning MindLinks**, the grade is passed back into Moodle (screenshot 2 below).
