Helena College Mission:

Helena College supports our diverse community by providing the paths and tools necessary to assist learners in achieving their educational and career goals.

- 1. The meeting provided a deeper dive into Helena College enrollment, retention, and completion data provided by Helena College's Institutional Researcher, Jessie Pate. (See attached slides.)
- 2. The group brainstormed questions including:
 - a. How can we promote the LPN program (as numbers have greatly declined)? Is there anything that our Community Advisory Board do to advocate changes to make this a more appealing educational path?
 - b. How do we promote the career paths and success stories of Helena College graduates? The data shows that we have many stories to share.
 - c. How can we get more information from those who do not return? Also, from those who do not graduate? Could we survey students?
 - d. Much of the data is specific to degree-seeking students. How do we get a better picture of the dual enrollment population (average credits, number of students completing general education core classes, where they go after Helena College, what long-term outcomes do we see in these students)?
 - i. How can we continue to promote the value of the gen ed certificate to dual enrollment students?
- 3. Next meeting: prepare for the Perkins Comprehensive Local Needs Assessment by looking at disaggregated student data by student type.


Non-Degree

 - <u>Early college</u> (high school students enrolled in courses taught by HC faculty)




Enrollment

Enrollment by CTE 5-Year Average




Definitions

- Academic Year (AY): Summer, fall, and spring terms
- CTE: Career Technical Education, programs designed to prepare students for a career in the skilled trades or a technical field
- **Unduplicated**: Each student is counted only once. For example, if a student is enrolled in both the fall and the spring semester, they are counted as one student for the academic year.






Fall Entering Cohort by CTE/Gen Ed


Definitions

- Entering Cohort: All new first-time, transfer in, and readmit/returning students who started at Helena College during the same period, usually in a fall semester.
- New first time: A student who has not attended college previously, excluding dual enrollment credit
- Returning: A student who has previously attended and earned credit at Helena College but has had a lapse in enrollment
- Transfer in: A student who has attended and earned credit at another institution






Retention Rates

Definitions

• **Fall to Fall Retention**: Percentage of fall entering cohort returning for either the subsequent spring or subsequent fall semester. Students who graduated in the fall, spring, or summer and did not return for the subsequent fall are also included.

Definitions

- 150% Graduation Rate: Percentage of students graduating within 150% of normal time to completion for the degree.
 - For associate degrees, this is 3 academic years.
 - For certificates, it is three semesters (not including summer).






Graduates by Program AY1920 to AY2324

Overall Degrees Awarded


