Budget Update (TF)

- There will be no reductions this year. The budget will stay flat for operations.
 - The 3% tuition increase offsets the 2% staff increase in November 2022.
- The estimation of revenue is based on flat enrollment.
 - If the enrollment is down, there may be changes.
- HC gets more funds in the second year of the biennium.
- HC will apply for the extra performance funding from MUS.
- Spreadsheets will be distributed soon and due back April 20-30.
- Fee pot spending authority.
 - Any funds tagged for the facility reversion must be approved by OCHE.

Fiscal Year-End (CS)

- Any procurement over \$5K must be in the system by May 15.
- ProCard charges must be done by June 1st.
- Complete invoicing for billing by the end of May to June 1st.
- Get late spending on the Business Office's radar.
- Complete GrizMart purchases under \$5000 by early June.
- Information will be published in the MMM.

Cost of Attendance (COA) 2022-2023 (VC)

- The BMT reviewed the entire spreadsheet.
 - Highlight: In-State Tuition Full Time \$21,295* is the COA for 2022-2023 vs. \$19,450 in 2021-2022
 - Books and supplies down 25% due to utilizing open-source materials.
 - Tuition 3% increase
 - 0% fee increase
 - Loan Fees average \$29



• Room and board increased.

* Valerie Curtin added \$50/month to the original projection for hotspots and the internet expense.

- Extra funds will not be as available in AY23.
 - SEOG grants are lower than the previous amount. \$20,000+ allotted this year.
 - Students may apply for emergency funds.
 - CTI can assist with the cost of hotspots and internet for students also.
