# **Facilities Condition Assessment (KT)**

- Kelley is requesting suggestions on how to inform the campus about the way decisions are made for improvements in preparation of his ID Days presentation.
  - Create a PowerPoint for faculty to show the process, the items already completed and upcoming projects.
  - o Include the six-year projection, how requests are assessed, and how priorities are set.
  - Survey the faculty and ask about classroom/lab improvements.
    - Use examples of the noise in DON123 and the lighting needs in the aviation lab.
  - o Explain different types of requests, i.e., Capital vs life safety project and legislative requests.

### NeoEd Learn Test Cohort Assessment & Campus Roll Out (KT)

- Each Director should be able to see the progress of each member.
  - o Two trainings are UM oriented. The FERPA training references UMs Data policy which is obsolete for HC.
  - o Suggestion: Drop the FERPA training and use Neo Learn FERPA instead.
- Digital Accessibility references the UM resources which is not available to the faculty.
  - o Solution: Include a disclaimer that the resources are not available and provide HC resources.
- Is there a way to do a force enrollment? Currently each employee has to enroll in the courses.
  - o No, because once enrolled, the system starts a completion clock.
  - Each director/supervisor will be responsible to check the progress of each member.
- The dashboard communication is misleading. It is mandatory, but you have to search for the information.
  - o The training access needs to be activated. A link will be posted after the bugs are worked out.
  - o Most of the training is beneficial.
