Annual Plans 2425 Initial Review Follow Up

- Out of 35 plans, one-half of the authors made changes or addressed the feedback from the reviewers.
 - Fifteen made changes.
 - Eight gave a reason for not making a change.
- Most of the changes improved the plan.
- Jessie Pate will send out the feedback to the developers.
- IDEA will continue checking feedback changes at mid-year to improve the plans.

Review of annual plan goals not completed 22-23 and 23-24. Deferred or not completed analysis.

- It was more difficult than anticipated to categorize the reason for not completing a goal.
 - Add this to the list of reasons: Reassigning the responsibility.



- Frequently, the goal was marked as not completed if there was only one indicator not completed out of multiple indicators that were completed.
- Decision: If it is marked not completed or deferred, add a check box to mark the reason it was not completed.
- Additional annual plan discussion: If a goal is marked in progress, then the goal
 automatically rolls over to the next year. Some people keep the goal, some edit
 it, and others delete the text and write a new goal entirely. If an area is removing
 an in-progress goal that has not been completed, IDEA would like to know why.
 - Decision:
 - Improve the prompt for writing goals. For goals carried over from a previous year, developers can keep the goal as is or make minor edits.
 - If they are completely changing the goal, they should delete the one that carried over and write a new one.
 - Add a feature for developers to explain why they are deleting a goal they didn't complete before they delete it.
 - Consider requiring an additional goal yearly if any goal is being carried over.

Membership Term Lengths

- Jess would like the term to be extended to three years for continuity. For now, departing members will be asked if they would like to stay on for one more year after they have completed two years. New members will be asked to serve for three years.
