Priorities for AY2425

1. Establish a shared understanding of the purpose of learning outcomes assessment
2. Identify the most appropriate location for all learning outcomes to be published
3. Develop a sustainable and comprehensive process for assessing student learning at the program and institutional level. Ideally, this will include a plan for reviewing the learning outcomes at all levels on a regular schedule.

2. Update: Certificate of General Students outcomes approved (1 min)
 - a. Are these in the assessment database? JP to ask BS about Gen Ed outcomes in public program information accessible from the course bank
 - b. Still need a place for all program/credential learning outcomes
 - i. Canvas Commons – only available to employees
 - ii. Is this required to be public for NWCCU or other orgs? Program pages are not reliably up to date, some issues in course bank, catalog is in flux. Pretty sure students need to be able to see outcomes
 - iii. Should keep in **one place** for consistency, ease of updating
3. Watermark demo follow-up (10 min)
 - a. Platform seems to be designed for directors, rather than individual faculty to enter the data and set up the mapping.
 - b. Likely more useful for IR, directors – reporting tools seem really powerful
 - c. Like that Watermark can pull data from Canvas and determine met/didn't meet
 - d. Lots of work up front, which can be especially challenging for courses taught by adjuncts
 - e. **Is there any way for mapping in Canvas to integrate with mapping in Watermark?**

- f. Could we get a different demo, more focused on the faculty perspective?**

 - a. Concerns about timing
 - i. Are we ready as a committee?
 - ii. All course, credential, and institutional outcomes need to be reviewed and possibly updated before we start mapping and loading it into Canvas, catalog, etc.
 - 1. Course outcomes are probably really good, as faculty have been using them for course level assessment
 - 2. Credential outcomes – possibly some concern that they aren’t measurable?
 - 3. Institutional outcomes – these need to be updated badly!
