The scholarship will help students pursue their career-connected learning path, aligning with both the chapter’s focus on education and safety and the college’s mission of preparing skilled workers for the aviation industry.

**Amount:** \$500.00 to one student for the Spring 2026 term

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

1. Students enrolled in the Aviation Maintenance Technology program
2. Students who have been successfully admitted to Helena College;
3. Students who are enrolled at Helena College seeking a degree or vocational certification;
4. Student needs to be successfully working towards their degree and on track to graduate with a 2.0 GPA and an 80% passage rate as required by the Aviation Maintenance Technology Program.

### **Application Materials:**

- 1-2 page essay on why you choose the Aviation Maintenance Technology Program, why you are passionate about Aviation, and how this scholarship will assist you in your academic goals.
- Copy of your Unofficial Transcripts
- Two letters of Professional Recommendation with contact information.

### **Selection Decision:**

Members of the EAA Chapter 344 will review all applications and select the scholarship recipient. The scholarship recipient must write an acknowledgement letter (thank you) to the EAA Chapter 344 Organization.

### **Application Procedure & Criteria:**
