Through a grant awarded to Helena College, funding for a \$500 scholarship has been designated and made available to a degree-seeking Helena College Veteran and/or Adult Learner students to be awarded the spring 2021 semester.

Eligibility Criteria:

Veteran

- 1. Students who receive veteran educational benefits, to include Chapter 1606, Chapter 35, and Chapter 33 benefits (less than 100% coverage), AND
- 2. Must be in good academic standing enrolled for at least 6 credits

OR

Adult Learner (25 year of age or older)

- 1. Cumulative College GPA range of 2.0 3.0 (if applicable), AND
- 2. Must file a FAFSA with results of an Expected Family Contribution (EFC) between 5329 7200, AND
- 3. Must be in good academic standing enrolled for at least 6 credits

Selection Decision:

Scholarship Committee: A committee consisting of Helena College staff and faculty will determine the recipients for these funds.

Each scholarship recipient will write an acknowledgement letter (thank you) in receipt of the scholarship award.

Application Procedure & Criteria:

- 1. Complete this application form and return it to the **Financial Aid Office** on or before the deadline.
- 2. 1-2 page typed essay explaining who you are, your educational goals, and how this scholarship will assist you in attaining them.
- 3. Optional: Attach two (2) letters of reference (one academic)
