

The Joe Smietanka Memorial Scholarship

A scholarship is available to a student who has been convicted of a felony and plans to pursue a degree or vocational certification at Helena College. The scholarship has been made available to assist with the cost of books, supplies or tools. A student returning to school will have preference.

Amount & Availability:

One scholarship, not to exceed \$250, will be available for spring 2023 and fall 2024 semester.

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. Students who have been convicted of a felony;
- 2. Students who have been successfully admitted to Helena College;
- 3. Students who are enrolled at Helena College seeking a degree or vocational certification.
- 4. A student who has received a scholarship in a prior semester shall not be precluded from receiving a scholarship for a subsequent semester.

Selection Decision:

Joe's family will evaluate each application to determine a recipient for each semester. The scholarship recipient must write an acknowledgement letter (thank you) to the donors.

Application Procedure & Criteria:

Complete the application form and other required documents listed below and return it to the Financial Aid Office on or before the deadline.

- Explain why the scholarship should be awarded to her or him.
- Provide documentation of book, supply or tool expenses
