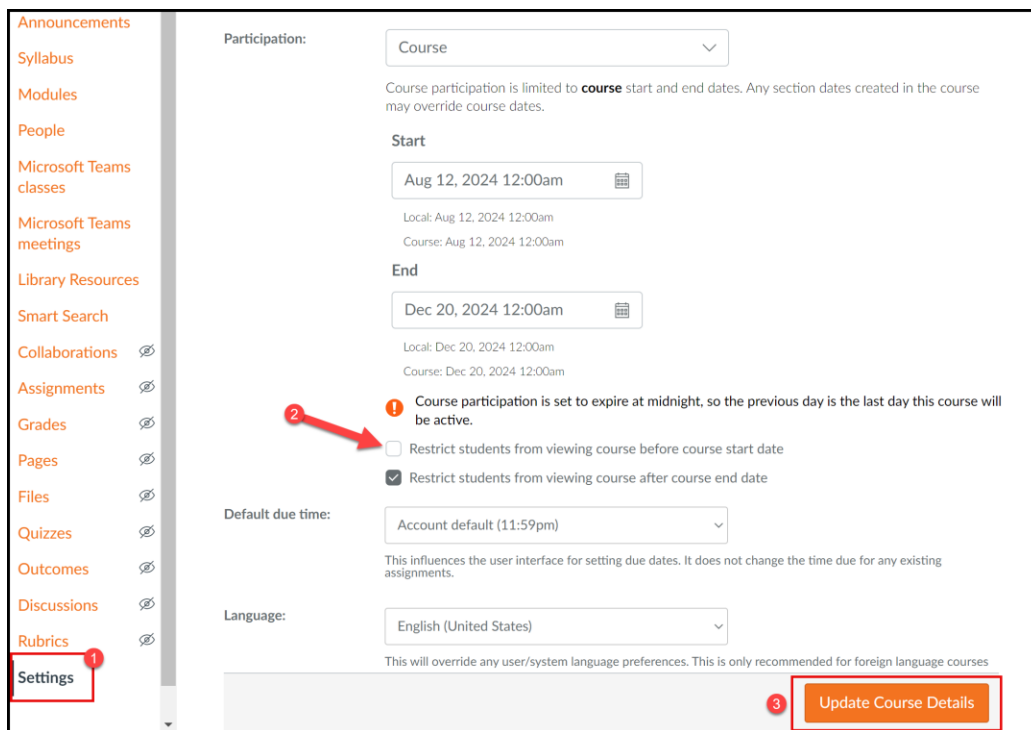


Allow Students Early Access to Courses Before Start Date

If an instructor wants to make the course accessible prior to its official start date, they have two options:

Option 1: Allow students to only view the course contents. (You can still unpublish any items in Modules you don't want students to see yet.)

- Instructors must publish the course and make sure that in your course settings the “Restrict students from viewing course before course start date” option is unchecked.

Course participation is limited to **course** start and end dates. Any section dates created in the course may override course dates.
