

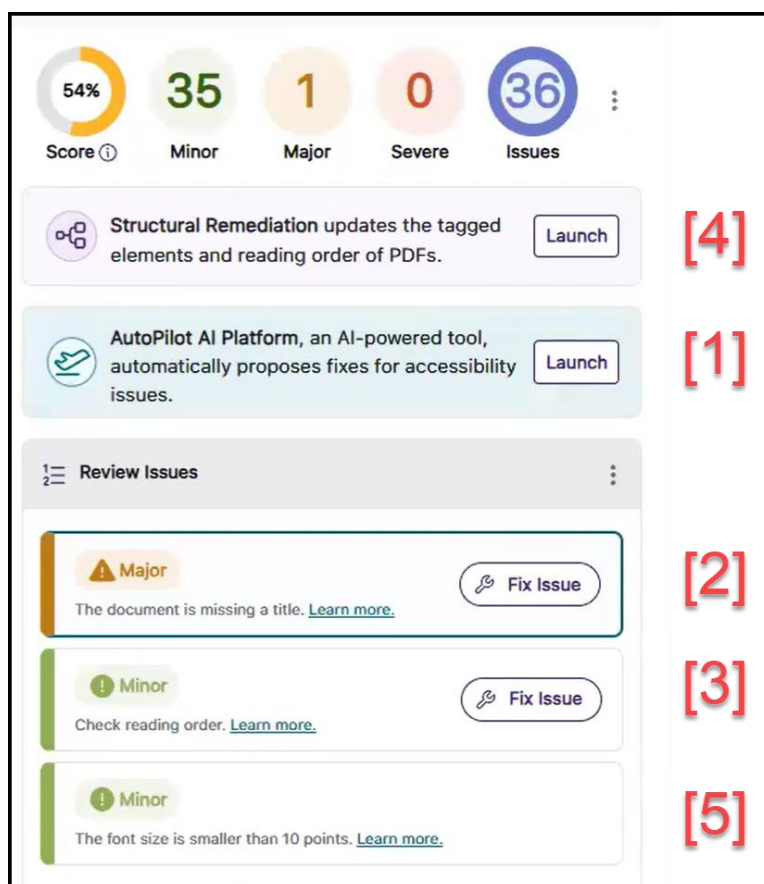
YuJa Panorama Accessibility Checker Tools

This handout provides guidance on using the **Remediation Engine**, **AutoPilot**, and **PDF Remediation Engine Max** tools to identify and address accessibility issues in your documents.

If this is your first time using Panorama in Canvas, you'll need to click the **Panorama LTI** link in the course navigation. Doing so will automatically generate your Panorama account. Once your account is created, you will have access to both **Autopilot** and the **Structural Remediation** tool.

If you do not see the Panorama LTI link in the course navigation, you may need to enable it by managing your course navigation settings. A helpful guide is available here:

Accessing YuJa Panorama in Your Course in Canvas

- On the course content page, you will see colored icons next to each file indicating its accessibility score.
- Click on the icon to view the accessibility report and the identified issues.

AutoPilot AI Platform

- **AutoPilot** may not always appear - It is only available when the identified issues qualify for auto-remediation.
- If **AutoPilot** option is available, always launch **AutoPilot** first [1], then address any remaining issues manually by clicking the **Fix Issue** option [2].
- Using AutoPilot for Course-Wide Fixes
 - Instructors do not need to fix accessibility issues one document at a time. They can automate course-wide accessibility fixes with AutoPilot.
 - Steps:
 - Go to the **Panorama** link in Course Navigation.
 - Select the **AutoPilot** tab.
 - Click **Run AutoPilot**.
 - Choose:
 - Your course
 - File formats (e.g., HTML, PDF, DOCX, PPTX, XLSX)
 - Click **Run and Confirm**.
 - AutoPilot will automatically fix all eligible issues.

Structural Remediation for PDFs

- If the file is a **PDF** and the identified issues involve reading order, styles, headings [3], etc., use the **Structure Remediation for PDFs** tool [4] to fix them directly within the document in Panorama in Canvas. This approach eliminates the need to download the PDF, make edits using Adobe (which requires Adobe Acrobat Pro license), and re-upload the file to the course.

Handling Accessibility Issues Beyond YuJa Panorama's Capabilities

- Some issues may not be fixable using Panorama tools.

- Download the file, fix the issue using appropriate tools, and re-upload it to your course in Canvas.
