Pathway Advising Notes: Students should be advised to complete the membership process of their chosen volunteer emergency services organization before starting FIRE298 Internship. Some organizations have lengthy membership processes. Students are required to complete one FIRE298 Internship session but may count up to 3 semesters. Note that at least 15 credits must be 200 Level.

Helena College provides students with the majority of gear needed for the program including turnout pants and coat, a helmet, mask, and SCBA. Students will need to pay for and provide their own structural firefighting books, gloves, a hood, ear plugs, and safety glasses. Please refer to the Helena College Catalog for a list of the required gear.

Course Advising Notes: FIRE101: Required, FIRE102 corequisite. Class is part of Montana IFSAC/Proboard Firefighter 1 Certification along with FIRE 102 and FIRE 110.

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AHMS144: Required.

M105 or M121: Required. Higher level may be substituted. M105 may be substituted if student is advised of potential reduced BS transfer options.

FIRE298: At least one session of FIRE298 Required. Up to three semesters are optional for credit. Student should have completed Fire Service Organization membership process BEFORE start of FIRE298.

FIRE110: Required. Class is part of Montana IFSAC/Proboard Firefighter 1 Certification along with FIRE 101 and FIRE 102.

BIOH104: Required Natural Science (BIOH201 may be substituted). Paramedic prerequisite.

WRIT101: Required. Paramedic prerequisite. Higher level may be substituted.

FIRE131: Required. Class is aligned with Montana IFSAC/Proboard Driver/Operator Pumping Apparatus Certification.

COMX115: Required. Paramedic prerequisite.

BIOH201 or Sci.: One additional natural science required. If BIOH 104 is completed, take any natural science. If BIOH 104 is not completed, BIOH201/211 science sequence is required.

NASX105: Recommended Diversity.

SPNS101 or FA: Recommended Humanities/Fine Arts.

PSYX100 or SSH: Recommended Social & Psychological Sciences/History.

FIRE202: Required. Class is aligned with Montana IFSAC/Proboard Firefighter II Certification.

FIRE298: At least one session of FIRE298 Required. Up to three semesters are optional for credit. Student should have completed Fire Service Organization membership process BEFORE start of FIRE298.

SPNS102 or FA: Recommended Humanities/Fine Arts.

PSYX240 or SSH: Recommended Social & Psychological Sciences/History

FIRE298: At least one session of FIRE298 Required. Up to three semesters are optional for credit. Student should have completed Fire Service Organization membership process BEFORE start of FIRE298.
